## Ros Canter and Lordships Graffalo show their class again – adding another Burghley Horse Trials title to their CV

ROS CANTER and Lordships Graffalo have cemented their place among the greatest eventing combinations of all time, winning a second successive Defender Burghley Horse Trials title.

Ros and "Walter", owned by Michele and Archie Saul,

won by nine penalties, the only combination to go clear inside the time across country. They add this second Burghley title to their two Mars Badminton wins, in 2023 and 2025, not

to mention Olympic team gold, and European team and individual gold. The 13-year-old British-bred gelding is the only horse to have won twice at both Badminton and Burghley.

"I hope he goes down as a legend of our sport, a legend of all time, not only

for his performances but for his character as well," said Ros, who is pregnant with her second child, and has adapted her riding style as a result. "I'm so grateful for the opportunities for myself, my team and my owners that we get to have with him.

"He's the horse of a lifetime and hopefully an inspiration to many."
